

## ***Illuminight* FAQs**

1) **Can anyone attend Illuminight?**

Yes. The event is family friendly. Kids 12 and under are free and everyone must register in advance.

2) **Why is there a registration fee to attend?**

We charge a nominal fee to cover the base costs of organizing and running *Illuminight*.

3) **What is included with my registration?**

All participants will receive a flashlight and event scarf. Food and entertainment is also provided at *Illuminight* to all participants.

4) **Where is Dyment's Farm and where can I park?**

Dyment's Farm is located at: [416 Fallsview Rd E, Dundas, ON L9H 5E2](#).  
Illuminight will take place in the barns beside the silos. Follow the signs to the entrance.

There is plenty of free parking available at Dyment's Farm. Please follow the directions from our parking volunteers upon arrival.

5) **Is *Illuminight* accessible?**

Activities, including food, entertainment and the indoor barn are fully accessible for attendees with wheelchairs and other mobility challenges. The walk itself is not accessible, as it is over farmland terrain. We will have a tractor and wagon to take guests through the route who are unable to walk the trail.

6) **Is it all outdoors?**

Yes, *Illuminight* is an outdoor event. There is shelter within the barns but please note they are NOT heated.

7) **What should I wear/bring?**

We recommend you wear comfortable and appropriate clothing for weather conditions. We also suggest appropriate shoes or boots for walking that can get dirty. We suggest you bring a water bottle with you. Water will also be provided on site.

**8) Are there prizes?**

Yes! Prizes are awarded to top fundraisers. Please visit the prize page on the website for more details and regulations. To qualify for prizes, all donations must be received by The Foundation by Wednesday, October 2 at 4 p.m.

**9) I've registered, how do I use my participant centre?**

Once registered you will have access to your *Illuminight* participant centre. We encourage you to share your story and why supporting Juravinski Hospital and Cancer Centre Foundation is important to you. Through your participant centre you can email friends and family to request donations. You can also keep track of all online and offline donations.

**10) Will donors receive a tax receipt?**

Donations of \$10 or more will be issued a tax receipt.

**11) What are "offline" donations**

Offline donations are cash or cheque donations that you receive (as opposed to "online" donation where supporters donate via credit card to your participant centre online). Offline donations can be brought to The Foundation main office (1 King Street West, Suite 702, Hamilton) or the satellite office at Juravinski Cancer Centre in advance. They can also be turned in at *Illuminight*.

**12) Who should cheque donations be made out to?**

Cheques can be made out to Hamilton Health Sciences Foundation.

**13) Do you have suggestions on how I can maximize my fundraising efforts?**

Reach out to family and friends, share you story on social media and ask for support. You could also hold a car wash, bake sale, or other event to fundraise toward your goal.

**14) Is there a minimum to fundraise in order to participate?**

No, there is no minimum to fundraise.

**15) How does my fundraising and participation in *Illuminight* impact Juravinski Hospital and Cancer Centre Foundation?**

We are focused on raising funds in support of the Cancer Program at Juravinski Hospital and Cancer Centre. Proceeds from *Illuminight* will go toward funding priority medical equipment to enhance care for cancer patients.

16) **What are Fundraising Flashes?**

Fundraising flashes are a series of mini-fundraising challenges intended to give participants extra incentive to fundraise in support of Juravinski Hospital and Cancer Centre Foundation. There is also the opportunity to win great prizes. Watch your email for full details.
